Subject: Conservation and development; land use; hunting; posting land;
municipal fee

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to repeal the fee payable to the town clerk to post land prohibiting hunting.

An act relating to the fee to post land prohibiting hunting

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 5201(c) is amended to read:

(c) The owner or person posting the lands shall record this posting annually in the town clerk's office of the town in which the land is located. The recording form shall be furnished by the commissioner and shall be filled out in triplicate, one copy to be retained by the town clerk, one copy to the commissioner, and one copy to be retained by the person having the right to post the lands. The forms shall contain the information as to the approximate number of acres posted, location in town, date of posting, and signature of person so posting the lands. The town clerk shall file the record, and it shall be
