5 Subject: Natural resources

6 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to include in an existing exemption
7 from stage II vapor recovery rules gasoline-dispensing facilities that replace
8 existing gasoline dispensers with used gasoline dispensers.

9 An act relating to replacement of gasoline dispensers

10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 583 is amended to read:

12 § 583. REPEAL OF STAGE II VAPOR RECOVERY REQUIREMENTS

13 (a) Effective January 1, 2013, all rules of the secretary pertaining to stage II
14 vapor recovery controls at gasoline dispensing facilities are repealed. The
15 secretary may not issue further rules requiring such controls. For purposes of
16 this section, “stage II vapor recovery” means a system for gasoline vapor
17 recovery of emissions from the fueling of motor vehicles as described in
18 42 U.S.C. § 7511a(b)(3).

19 (b) Prior to January 1, 2013, stage II vapor recovery rules shall not apply
20 to:

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(4) Any existing gasoline dispensing facility that, after May 1, 2009,

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replaces all of its existing gasoline dispensers with ~~new~~ gasoline dispensers

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that support triple data encryption standard (TDES) usage or replaces one or

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more of its gasoline dispensers pursuant to a plan to achieve full TDES

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compliance, upon verification and approval by the secretary.

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Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE; RETROACTIVE APPLICATION

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This act shall take effect on passage. Notwithstanding 1 V.S.A. § 214, this

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act shall apply retroactively to gasoline dispensers installed at an existing

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gasoline-dispensing facility after May 1, 2009.
