7 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to ratify the National Crime
8 Prevention and Privacy Compact which permits the interstate exchange of
9 criminal history records for noncriminal justice purposes.

10 An act relating to National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact

11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

12 Sec. 1. 20 V.S.A. § 2056i is added to read:

13 § 2065. RATIFICATION OF THE NATIONAL CRIME PREVENTION

14 AND PRIVACY COMPACT

15 (a) The Vermont general assembly hereby approves and ratifies the
16 National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact, 42 U.S.C. sections
17 14611–14616. The compact shall remain in effect until legislation is enacted
18 renouncing or rescinding the compact.

19 (b) The commissioner of the department of public safety shall execute,
20 administer, and implement the compact on behalf of the state, and may adopt

1 rules as necessary for the national exchange of criminal history records for
2 noncriminal justice purposes.

3 (c) Criminal history records as defined in subdivision 2056a(a)(1) of this
4 title shall be made available to lawfully entitled requestors in other states
5 according to the provisions of the National Crime Prevention and Privacy
6 Compact.

7 (d) Nothing in this section shall alter the duties and responsibilities of the
8 commissioner of the department of public safety regarding the dissemination
9 of criminal history records within the state of Vermont pursuant to statute.
