Subject: State property; John H. Boylan state airport; sale

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to direct the commissioner of buildings and general services to sell the John H. Boylan state airport in Island Pond.

An act relating to sale of the John H. Boylan state airport

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. SALE OF THE JOHN H. BOYLAN STATE AIRPORT

(a) Notwithstanding 5 V.S.A. § 204(3), the commissioner of buildings and general services is directed to sell:

(1) the John H. Boylan state airport to the Vermont Biomass Energy Company at fair market value; and

(2) the residence and up to an acre of associated land on the airport property to the highest bidder, provided that the residence and land shall not be sold for less than fair market value.

(b) Proceeds from the sale under subsection (a) of this section shall be deposited into the capital fund pursuant to 29 V.S.A. § 166(d).

1 (c) The secretary of transportation shall direct the owners of the airplane
2 hangars on the property to remove the buildings by a date mutually agreed
3 upon between the secretary and commissioner of buildings and general
4 services.
