ORDERS OF THE DAY

ACTION CALENDAR

Favorable with Amendment

H. 11

An act relating to the disposition of property upon death, transfer of interest in vehicle upon death, and homestead exemption.

Rep. Jewett of Ripton, for the Committee on **Judiciary**, recommends the bill be amended as follows:

First: In Sec. 2, 14 V.S.A. § 311(2), by striking the comma after the words “descendants of the decedent”

Second: In Sec. 2, 14 V.S.A. § 312, in the last sentence, by inserting the words “or civil union” after the word “marriage” and before the comma

Third: In Sec. 2, 14 V.S.A. § 314, by striking subdivision (b)(3) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (b)(3) to read as follows:

(3) one-half of the intestate estate to the decedent’s paternal grandparents equally if they both survive or to the surviving paternal grandparent and one-half of the intestate estate to the decedent’s maternal grandparents equally if they both survive or to the surviving maternal grandparent but if decedent is survived by a grandparent, or grandparents on only one side, to that grandparent or those grandparents;

Fourth: In Sec. 2, 14 V.S.A. § 320, by inserting the words “or in a civil union with” after the words “married to”

Fifth: In Sec. 2, 14 V.S.A. § 321, in the first sentence, by striking the words “during marriage” and inserting in lieu thereof the words “during a marriage or civil union and not to take effect until after the individual’s death” before the comma

Sixth: In Sec. 2, 14 V.S.A. § 338, in subsection (a)(1) by striking the word “distributes” and inserting in lieu thereof the word “distributees”

Seventh: By adding a Sec. 6 to read as follows:

Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

(a) Sections 1, 2, 4, and 5 of this act shall take effect upon passage. Sec. 2 of this act shall apply only to the estates of persons dying on or after the

effective date of this act.

(b) Sec. 3 of this act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
