Moves the bill be amended as follows:

First: In Sec. 1, 10 V.S.A. § 1452, by inserting a new subdivision (6) to read as follows:

(6) “Lessee” means a person who acquires the right to occupancy or use of property under a lease or rental agreement.

and by renumbering subdivisions (6) and (7) to be numerically correct

Second: In Sec. 1, 10 V.S.A. § 1457(a), in the second sentence by striking the word “occupant” where it appears and inserting in lieu thereof “lessee”

INFORMATION NOTICE

The following item was recently received by the Joint Fiscal Committee:

JFO #2370 — \$19,600,000 grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to the Agency of Commerce and Community Affairs – Housing and Community Affairs. These funds were allocated to Vermont for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program authorized under the Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008 and are intended to assist the State in addressing problems created by abandoned and foreclosed residential properties.
