

No. 2. An act relating to challenges for change outcomes for persons with disabilities.

(H.1)

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. Sec. C23 of No. 146 of the Acts of the 2009 Adj. Sess. (2010) is amended to read:

Sec. C23. RESTATEMENT OF OUTCOMES FOR INDIVIDUALS
WITH DISABILITIES, MENTAL HEALTH NEEDS, OR
SUBSTANCE ABUSE ISSUES

Outcomes for individuals with disabilities, mental health needs, or substance abuse issues:

(1) Children, families, and individuals are engaged in and contribute to their community's decisions and activities.

(2) Elders, people with disabilities, and individuals with mental health conditions live with dignity and independence in settings they prefer.

~~(2)~~(3) Families and individuals live in safe and supportive communities.

~~(3)~~(4) Adults lead healthy and productive lives.

~~(4)~~(5) Vermonters receive affordable and appropriate health care at the appropriate time, and health care costs are contained over time.

~~(5)~~(6) Families and individuals move out of poverty through education and advancement in employment.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
