

No. 7. An act relating to adding a member from the area agencies on aging to the governor's commission on Alzheimer's disease and related disorders.

(S.12)

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 3 V.S.A. § 3085b(b) is amended to read:

(b) The commission shall be composed of ~~16~~ 17 members: the commissioner of disabilities, aging, and independent living or a designee, one senator chosen by the committee on committees of the senate, one representative chosen by the speaker of the house, and ~~13~~ 14 members appointed by the governor. The members appointed by the governor shall represent the following groups: physicians, social workers, nursing home managers, the clergy, adult day center providers, the business community, registered nurses, residential care home operators, family care providers, the home health agency, the legal profession, mental health service providers, the area agencies on aging, and the Alzheimer's association. The members appointed by the governor shall represent, to the degree possible, the five regions of the state.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
