5 Subject: Conservation and development; fish and game; licenses; veterans

6 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to provide a free combination
7 hunting and fishing license to Vermont veterans of the armed forces who are
8 disabled to the extent that employment is not possible.

9 An act relating to hunting and fishing licenses for disabled Vermont
10 veterans

11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

12 Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 4255(c)(4) is amended to read:

13 (4) A Vermont resident who is a veteran of the armed forces of the
14 United States and who is, ~~or ever has been, one hundred percent~~ disabled as a
15 ~~result of a service-connected disability~~ to the extent that employment is not
16 possible may receive a free combination hunting and fishing license which
17 shall include all big game licenses upon presentation of a certificate issued by
18 the veterans' administration so certifying. A resident of a state which provides
19 a reciprocal privilege for Vermont veterans and who would qualify for a free

- 1 license under this subdivision if the person were a Vermont resident, may
- 2 receive a free one-year combination hunting and fishing license.
