5 Subject: Human services; child care; child care subsidy

6 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to raise from 12 to 14 the maximum
7 age at which an eligible child may qualify for a child care subsidy.

9 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 § 3511. DEFINITIONS

12 As used in this chapter:

13 (1) "Child" means an individual under the age of ~~13~~ 15.

14 (2) "Child care provider" means a person licensed or registered by the
15 department for children and families, or authorized by the department, to
16 provide child care.

17 (3) "Child care services" include, but are not limited to,
18 developmentally appropriate care and supervision for children under the age of
19 ~~13~~ 15 for fewer than 24 hours a day by a child care provider.
