8 Subject: Fish and wildlife; felt-soled boots and waders; informational displays

9 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to require Vermont retail stores  
10 selling felt-soled boots and waders to inform customers of the ban on the use  
11 of these products prior to sale.

12 An act relating to informing consumers about the ban on felt-soled boot and  
13 wader use

14 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

15 Sec. 1. BAN ON FELT-SOLED BOOTS AND WADERS; INFORMING  
16 CONSUMERS

17 Vermont retail stores offering for sale external felt-soled boots or external  
18 felt-soled waders must inform consumers of the April 1, 2011 ban on the use of  
19 these products prior to the ban's enactment and for a period of two years after  
20 the ban's enactment by:

1           (1) placing a conspicuous informational display about the ban in close  
2           proximity to affected products on display for retail sale; and

3           (2) informing customers purchasing affected products about the ban at  
4           the time of sale.

5           Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

6           This act shall take effect on passage.
