8 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to require the department of

9 buildings and general services to report on bicycle racks on the grounds of

10 state buildings.

11 An act relating to requiring a report on bicycle racks on the grounds of state
12 buildings

13 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14 Sec. 1. REPORT ON BICYCLE RACKS ON THE GROUNDS OF STATE

15 BUILDINGS

16 By July 1, 2012, the department of buildings and general services shall file

17 a report with the general assembly which shall include the following:

18 (1) the number and location of state buildings in Vermont that have

19 bicycle racks; a description of those racks; where on the grounds of those state

1 buildings the racks are located; and how visible and accessible those racks are
2 to bicyclists; and

3 (2) any plans the department has for the installation and repair of bicycle
4 racks at state buildings in Vermont over the next three years.

5 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

6 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
