Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to approve amendments to the charter  
of the city of Rutland.

An act relating to amending the charter of the city of Rutland

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. CHARTER APPROVAL

The general assembly approves the amendments to the charter of the city of  
Rutland as set forth in this act. Proposals of amendment were approved by the  
voters on March 1, 2011.

Sec. 2. 24 App. V.S.A. chapter 9 is amended to read:

CHAPTER 9. CITY OF RUTLAND

1 Subchapter 22. Police Department

3 § 22.11. SUSPENSION

4 The chief of police shall have the power, for disciplinary purposes, to  
5 suspend any member of the department, without pay, for a period not to exceed  
6 ~~two (2)~~ six (6) weeks. The police commission shall have the power to suspend  
7 the chief of police for a period not to exceed two (2) weeks.

9 Subchapter 23. Fire Department

11 § 23.8. SUSPENSIONS

12 The chief engineer shall have the power, for disciplinary purposes, to  
13 suspend any member of the department without pay for a period not to exceed
