4 Subject: Town lines; town of Shelburne; town of St. George

5 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to establish the boundary line  
6 between the towns of Shelburne and St. George.

7 An act relating to establishing the boundary line between the towns of  
8 Shelburne and St. George

9 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

10 Sec. 1. TOWN LINES; TOWNS OF SHELBURNE AND ST. GEORGE;  
11 ESTABLISHMENT; RATIFICATION

12 (a) The general assembly finds that it may establish town lines under  
13 Chapter II, § 6 of the Constitution of the State of Vermont.

14 (b) The towns of Shelburne and St. George, by and through their respective  
15 selectboards, have petitioned the general assembly to determine the boundary  
16 line between these two towns as set forth in a plan of survey entitled “Town  
17 Line Agreement between Towns of: Shelburne & St. George Chittenden  
18 County State of Vermont” conducted by a licensed land surveyor employed by  
19 Civil Engineering Associates, Inc. and dated March 9, 2011.

1        (c) By this act, the general assembly ratifies the existence of the boundary  
2        line between the towns of Shelburne and St. George as set forth in the plan of  
3        survey entitled “Town Line Agreement between Towns of: Shelburne &  
4        St. George Chittenden County State of Vermont” conducted by a licensed  
5        land surveyor employed by Civil Engineering Associates, Inc. and dated  
6        March 9, 2011.

7        Sec. 2. APPLICATION

8        Upon passage of this act, the selectboards of the towns of Shelburne and  
9        St. George shall comply with the provisions of 24 V.S.A. § 1461(b)(2).

10       Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

11       This act shall take effect on passage.
