9 Subject: State buildings; restrooms; gender neutral

10 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to require that all single-occupancy
11 restrooms in state buildings be gender neutral.

12 An act relating to restrooms in state buildings

13 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14 Sec. 1. RESTROOMS IN STATE BUILDINGS

15 By September 15, 2012, all single-occupancy restrooms with an outer door
16 that can be locked by the occupant and located in a building owned by the state
17 shall be available for use regardless of the gender of the user.

18 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

19 This act shall take effect on passage.
