5 Subject: Motor vehicles; attempting to elude a police officer; penalties

6 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to raise from a misdemeanor to a
7 felony the penalty for attempting to elude a police officer and to raise the
8 penalties for the offense when death or bodily injury results.

9 An act relating to raising the penalties for attempting to elude a police
10 officer

11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

12 Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1133 is amended to read:

13 § 1133. ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE A POLICE OFFICER

14 (a) No operator of a motor vehicle shall fail to bring his or her vehicle to a
15 stop when signaled to do so by an enforcement officer:

16 (1) displaying insignia identifying him or her as such; or

17 (2) operating a law enforcement vehicle sounding a siren and displaying
18 a flashing blue or blue and white signal lamp.

1 (b)(1) A person who violates subsection (a) of this section shall be
2 imprisoned for not more than ~~one year~~ five years or fined not more than
3 \$1,000.00, or both.

4 (2)(A) In the event that death ~~or serious bodily injury~~ to any person
5 other than the operator is proximately caused by the operator's knowing
6 violation of subsection (a) of this section, the operator shall be imprisoned for
7 not ~~more than five years~~ less than one year nor more than 15 years or fined not
8 more than ~~\$3,000.00~~ \$10,000.00, or both.

9 (B) If death ~~or serious bodily injury~~ to more than one person other
10 than the operator is proximately caused by the operator's knowing violation of
11 subsection (a) of this section, the operator may be convicted of a separate
12 violation of this subdivision for each decedent ~~or person injured~~.

13 (3)(A) In the event that serious bodily injury to any person other than
14 the operator is proximately caused by the operator's knowing violation of
15 subsection (a) of this section, the operator shall be imprisoned for not more
16 than 15 years or fined not more than \$5,000.00, or both.

17 (B) If serious bodily injury to more than one person other than the
18 operator is proximately caused by the operator's knowing violation of
19 subsection (a) of this section, the operator may be convicted of a separate
20 violation of this subdivision for each person injured.
