5 Subject: Commerce and trade; lead; food; consumer protection

6 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to delete the reference to food,
7 vitamins, and other supplements from Vermont's lead in consumer products
8 law so that the amount of lead in such ingestible products may be measured
9 against a standard that is more restrictive than that for toys and similar items.

10 An act relating to lead in food and other edible products

11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

12 Sec. 1. 9 V.S.A. § 2470e is amended to read:

13 § 2470e. DEFINITIONS

14 As used in this subchapter:

15 (1) "Children's product" means any consumer product marketed for use
16 by children under the age of 12, or whose substantial use or handling by
17 children under 12 years of age is reasonably foreseeable, including toys,
18 furniture, jewelry, ~~vitamins and other supplements~~, personal care products,
19 clothing, ~~food~~, and food containers and packaging.
