5 Subject: Health; regulated drugs; hallucinogenic drug; synthetic stimulants

6 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to prohibit the possession or sale of  
7 “bath salts” and similar drugs.

8 An act relating to prohibiting synthetic stimulants

9 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

10 Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 4201 is amended to read:

11 § 4201. DEFINITIONS

13 (10) “Hallucinogenic drugs” means stramonium, mescaline or peyote,  
14 lysergic acid diethylamide, and psilocybin, and all synthetic equivalents of  
15 chemicals contained in resinous extractives of cannabis sativa, synthetic  
16 stimulants, or any salts or derivatives or compounds of any preparations or  
17 mixtures thereof, and any other substance which is designated as habit-forming  
18 or as having a serious potential for abuse arising out of its effect on the central  
19 nervous system or its hallucinogenic effect in the regulations adopted by the  
20 board of health under section 4202 of this title.
