

Act No. 108 (H.543). Public Records, Executive Branch

An act relating to records and reports of the Auditor of Accounts

This act repeals from session law requirements related to following up on audit recommendations and to online posting of audit reports, information related to audit recommendations, and information on false claims and embezzlement convictions, and codifies these requirements in the Vermont Statutes Annotated.

This act also creates a Public Records Act exemption for draft audit reports and working papers until a final audit report is completed; reduces the number of copies of audit reports that must be submitted to the State Library from 10 to 1; repeals a session law requirement that the Auditor of Accounts report annually to the House and Senate Committees on Appropriations on any findings, issues, and recommendations arising from audit reports; and authorizes municipalities to send their annual municipal reports to the State Library and to various State agencies electronically.
