

**Act No. 114 (H.347). Agriculture; professions and occupations; veterinary medicine; veterinary dentistry**

**An act relating to veterinary dentistry**

This act prohibits the performance of dental operations on an animal without a veterinary license. Dental operation is defined to mean using an instrument or device on an animal's teeth or gums to treat or prevent any injury or disease. Use of handheld tools to float equine teeth is exempted from this requirement, but power-assisted floating is not.

Effective Date: July 1, 2014
