

Act No. 181 (H.413). Crimes and criminal procedures

An act relating to the Uniform Collateral Consequences of Conviction Act

This act requires that individuals be given notice of the various penalties and disqualifications that they face incidental to their criminal sentencing, in certain circumstances provides a mechanism to seek partial relief from those penalties and disqualifications. Such relief is not available for offenders who convicted of a listed crime as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 5301 or trafficking of regulated drugs pursuant to 18 V.S.A. chapter 84.

Multiple effective dates, beginning on June 10, 2014
