

Act No. M-17 (H.892). Municipal charters; Central Vermont Public Safety Authority

An act relating to approval of the adoption and the codification of the charter of the Central Vermont Public Safety Authority

This act establishes the Central Vermont Public Safety Authority and adopts and codifies a charter for the Authority. The Authority is designed to provide public safety services (fire, police, ambulance, and dispatch) to the towns that are members of the Authority. As of the date of enactment, the Cities of Barre and Montpelier are members of the Authority. Additional towns may become members of the Authority and towns may withdraw from the Authority pursuant to the processes set forth in the charter.
