An act relating to granting staff of the Departments of Corrections and for Children and Families ex officio status for notary public services

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 32 V.S.A. § 1403(b) is amended to read:

(b) A county clerk shall, upon application, issue to a town clerk, a state police officer, a municipal police officer, a fish and game warden, a sheriff or deputy sheriff, ~~and a motor vehicle inspector,~~ an employee of the Department of Corrections, and an employee of the Department for Children and Families certification of notary public without charge or fee. A town clerk, state police officer, municipal police officer, fish and game warden, sheriff or deputy sheriff, ~~or motor vehicle inspector,~~ an employee of the Department of Corrections, or an employee of the Department for Children and Families shall provide notary public services without charge or fee.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
