Subject: Public safety; emergency management; municipalities

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to (1) authorize  
the emergency management director or local fire chief to order evacuations  
under certain circumstances; (2) permit municipalities to appropriate funds for  
repair work in certain emergency circumstances; and (3) authorize cities and  
towns to enter into mutual aid arrangements and form mutual aid districts  
without prior approval of the Governor.

An act relating to emergency management in municipalities

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 20 V.S.A. § 6 is amended to read:

§ 6. LOCAL ORGANIZATION FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

\* \* \*

(e) The emergency management director or fire chief may order the  
evacuation of individuals living or working within a danger area if there is an  
immediate and present threat within that area to life or health.

1       (f) If the Governor declares a state of local emergency in accordance with  
2 section 9 of this chapter, the legislative body of a municipality may, by  
3 resolution, adopt special emergency appropriations to pay for extraordinary  
4 expenses for the repair and reconstruction of streets, roads, or bridges or other  
5 public property damaged by flood, tropical storm, or hurricane when those  
6 repairs require that the municipality expend money in excess of appropriations  
7 approved at the municipality's annual meeting and the expenditure will exceed  
8 the total amount appropriated. The resolution adopting the special emergency  
9 appropriation shall designate the source of funds that will be appropriated. The  
10 legislative body shall report on the special emergency appropriation at the next  
11 special or annual meeting.

12       Sec. 2. 20 V.S.A. § 6a is added to read:

13       § 6a. LOCAL MUTUAL AID ARRANGEMENTS AND DISTRICTS

14       Each town and city may enter into mutual aid arrangements and form  
15 mutual aid districts for purposes similar to those listed for mutual aid  
16 agreements with other states as set forth in section 8 of this chapter and for the  
17 purposes of giving and receiving fire, rescue, emergency medical, law  
18 enforcement, and public works assistance. These agreements or districts may  
19 be intrastate or interstate. A mutual aid district formed under this section shall  
20 be a municipal corporation. Whenever rendering aid or assistance pursuant to  
21 this section, the officers and members shall have the same powers, duties,

1 rights, privileges, and immunities as if they were performing their duties in the  
2 political subdivision in which they are usually employed but shall work within  
3 the authority of the other political subdivision.

4 Sec. 3. 20 V.S.A. § 8 is amended to read:

5 § 8. GENERAL POWERS OF GOVERNOR

6 (a) The ~~governor~~ Governor shall have general direction and control of the  
7 emergency management agency and shall be responsible for the carrying out of  
8 the provisions of this chapter.
