6 Subject: Motor vehicles; driving privileges

7 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to authorize the  
8 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to issue driving privilege cards to Vermont  
9 residents unable to establish lawful presence in the United States, provided that  
10 applicants for driving privilege cards supply reliable proof of identity and  
11 residency and submit fingerprints. Any driving privilege card issued must  
12 clearly state on its face that it is not valid for identification purposes.

13 Fingerprints shall be checked against state and regional criminal records  
14 databases to determine if the applicant has a felony conviction or is the subject  
15 of an outstanding arrest warrant. The U.S. Immigration and Customs  
16 Enforcement Agency shall be notified if the applicant has had a felony  
17 conviction, and the appropriate law enforcement agency shall be notified of  
18 any outstanding arrest warrant.
