6 Subject: Municipal government; economic development; historic downtown

7 development; transportation

8 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to improve
9 transportation in designated downtowns, village centers, new town centers, and
10 growth centers by requiring a transportation management plan to be included
11 in a district's capital improvement plan. A transportation management plan
12 shall include a strategy to manage the district's transportation demands and
13 increase pedestrian and bike paths to improve connection between community
14 areas within the district. A new town center will also be required to include a
15 strategy for reducing reliance on single occupancy vehicles. If a state-owned
16 building or facility is located in a designated village center, state employees
17 and the visiting public must be provided with transportation alternatives to
18 access such building or facility.
