5 Subject: Health; health insurance; Vermont Health Benefit Exchange

6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to enable
7 individuals and small groups to purchase health insurance outside the Vermont
8 Health Benefit Exchange through December 31, 2014.

9 An act relating to the purchase of health insurance outside the Exchange

10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 Sec. 1. INTENT

12 It is the intent of the General Assembly that individuals and small
13 businesses in Vermont be allowed to choose whether to purchase health
14 insurance through the Vermont Health Benefit Exchange or in the traditional
15 health insurance marketplace during calendar year 2014. While the
16 administration works out the details of implementing the Exchange,
17 Vermonters should be comfortable with the choices available to them and free
18 to choose from among all available insurance options, whether through the
19 Exchange or outside it.

2 (c) Notwithstanding Sec. 41(i) of this act, repealing 8 V.S.A. §§ 4080a and
3 4080b, and notwithstanding the provisions of 33 V.S.A. § 1811, the

6 forms for nongroup and small group health insurance plans under the statutes

9 ~~health access or a health insurer is unable to facilitate enrollment in health~~

12 ~~small employers to extend coverage under an existing health insurance plan.~~
13 ~~The department of financial regulation and the Green Mountain Care board~~
14 ~~shall maintain their authority pursuant to this subsection until the exchange is~~
15 ~~able to enroll all qualified individuals and small employers who apply for~~
16 ~~coverage through the exchange~~ through December 31, 2014, as long as such
17 plans comply with Affordable Care Act requirements for health insurance
18 plans offered outside a health benefit exchange.

20 This act shall take effect on passage.
