7 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to authorize cash

8 advances for members of boards and commissions when traveling as part of

9 their official duties.

10 An act relating to authorizing cash advances for members of boards and
11 commissions when traveling as part of their official duties

12 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

13 Sec. 1. 32 V.S.A. § 1010(c) is amended to read:

14 (c) The members of the boards, commissions, and departments, including
15 those members serving ex officio or otherwise regularly employed by the
16 State, shall receive their actual and necessary expenses when away from home
17 or office upon their official duties. The members of boards and commissions
18 who are not employed by the State of Vermont may receive cash advances to
19 pay for their expenses when away from home or office upon their official
20 duties. Boards, commissions, and departments offering cash advances shall

1 develop procedures to ensure that cash advances are provided consistent with
2 generally accepted government auditing standards.

4 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
