6 Subject: Education; supervisory unions; school districts; budgets

7 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to enact the  
8 resolution adopted by the Cavendish electorate at the 2013 Town Meeting by a  
9 vote of 200 to 40 as follows: “We the people of Cavendish resolve that the  
10 Vermont Legislature must codify into the Vermont Statutes our inalienable  
11 right to a separate and distinct vote on school supervisory union budgets.” The  
12 bill would require that each school district board present the supervisory union  
13 budget to the voters of the district as a separate article in the warning for the  
14 district budget, expressing the entire sum of the supervisory union budget to be  
15 voted upon and also indicating the district’s proportionate share. A  
16 supervisory union budget would be established only if each member district  
17 voted in favor of the supervisory union budget.
