5 Subject: Vermont Employees' Retirement System; early retirement; law
6 enforcement

7 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow certain
8 employees who exercise law enforcement powers to receive an early
9 retirement allowance equal to their normal retirement allowance.

10 An act relating to allowing certain employees who exercise law
11 enforcement powers to receive an early retirement allowance equal to their
12 normal retirement allowance

13 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14 Sec. 1. 3 V.S.A. § 459(d)(4) is amended to read:

15 (4) Notwithstanding subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection, the
16 following shall upon early retirement receive an early retirement allowance
17 which shall be equal to his or her normal retirement allowance computed under
18 subsection (b) of this section:

19 (A) an employee of the Department of Fish and Wildlife assigned to
20 law enforcement duties;

1 (e) Notwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, the following shall be
2 entitled to a retirement allowance which shall increase or decrease by a
3 percentage equal to the Consumer Price Index for the preceding year:

4 (1) an employee of the Department of Liquor Control who exercises law
5 enforcement powers;

6 (2) a motor vehicle inspector;

7 (3) a full-time deputy sheriff employed by the State of Vermont;

8 (4) a full-time member of the Capitol Police force; and

9 (5) an investigator employed by the Criminal Division of the Office of
10 the Attorney General, Department of State's Attorneys, Department of Health,
11 or Secretary of State who has attained full-time certification from the Vermont
12 Criminal Justice Training Council and who is required to perform law
13 enforcement duties as the primary function of employment.

15 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
