6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow first and
7 third class licenses for a seasonal restaurant to be valid for one year from the
8 date of issuance.

9 An act relating to first class alcoholic beverage licenses

10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 242 is added to read:

12 § 242. LICENSES FOR SEASONAL RESTAURANTS

13 Notwithstanding section 232 of this title, a first or third class license
14 acquired by a seasonal restaurant shall be valid for one year from the date it is
15 issued. A seasonal restaurant shall pay only the pro-rata share of the first or
16 third class license fee reflecting the portion of the license term that the
17 restaurant is in operation.

18 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

19 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
