12 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

13 Sec. 1. 32 V.S.A. § 1403(b) is amended to read:

14 (b) A county clerk shall, upon application, issue to a town clerk, a state
15 police officer, a municipal police officer, a fish and game warden, a sheriff or
16 deputy sheriff, ~~and~~ a motor vehicle inspector, an employee of the Department
17 of Corrections, and an employee of the Department for Children and Families
18 certification of notary public without charge or fee. A town clerk, state police
19 officer, municipal police officer, fish and game warden, sheriff or deputy
20 sheriff, ~~or~~ motor vehicle inspector, an employee of the Department of

1 Corrections, or an employee of the Department for Children and Families shall
2 provide notary public services without charge or fee.

4 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
