6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow the  
7 holder of a first class license to serve up to four glasses of malt beverages to a  
8 customer at a single time.

10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 222 is amended to read:

12 § 222. FIRST AND SECOND CLASS LICENSES, GRANTING OF; SALE  
13 TO MINORS; CONTRACTING FOR FOOD SERVICE

14 With the approval of the ~~liquor control board~~ Liquor Control Board, the  
15 control commissioners may grant to a retail dealer for the premises where the  
16 dealer carries on business the following:

17 \* \* \*

18 (5) The holder of a first class license may serve up to four glasses of  
19 malt beverages to a customer at one time. If the number of glasses served to a

1 customer at a single time exceeds two, each glass shall contain no more than  
2 eight ounces of malt beverage.
