5 Subject: Motor vehicles; Vermont Strong plates

6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to extend by two
7 years, to June 30, 2016, the period during which certain Vermont registered
8 motor vehicles may display Vermont Strong commemorative plates.

9 An act relating to Vermont Strong plates

10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 Sec. 1. 2012 Acts and Resolves No. 71, Sec. 1, as amended by 2012 Acts and
12 Resolves No. 143, Sec. 13, is amended to read:

13 Sec. 1. VERMONT STRONG MOTOR VEHICLE PLATES

15 (c) Use. An approved Vermont Strong commemorative plate may be
16 displayed on a motor vehicle registered in Vermont as a pleasure car or on a
17 motor truck registered in Vermont for less than 26,001 pounds (but excluding
18 vehicles registered under the International Registration Plan) by covering the
19 front registration plate with the commemorative plate any time from the
20 effective date of this act until June 30, ~~2014~~ 2016. The regular front

1 registration plate shall not be removed. The regular rear registration plate shall
2 be in place and clearly visible at all times.

4 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

5 This act shall take effect on June 30, 2014.
