House concurrent resolution congratulating the 2013 Woodstock Union High School Wasps Division III championship football team

Whereas, the Woodstock Union High School Wasps football team won the Division III championship in 2011 and 2012, and

Whereas, in 2013, the Wasps continued to demonstrate their command of the pigskin, as they maintained an undefeated record throughout the regular season and preliminary playoff competition, and

Whereas, on November 9, 2013, the Woodstock football team took to the gridiron in Rutland, where it faced the Mill River Union High School Minutemen, and
