House resolution relating to amending Rule 25 of the Rules and Orders of the House of Representatives to grant jurisdiction relating to the policies of the State of Vermont's information technology systems to the Committee on Government Operations

Offered by: Representatives Sweaney of Windsor, Cole of Burlington, Consejo of Sheldon, Devereux of Mount Holly, Evans of Essex, Higley of Lowell, Hubert of Milton, Townsend of Randolph, and Townsend of South Burlington

Whereas, the State of Vermont's information technology systems are an integral part of the State's day-to-day operation, and

Whereas, the policies regarding the State's information technology systems should ensure the best use, integrity, accessibility, and advancement of those systems, and

Whereas, to ensure that the State of Vermont is operating under the best information technology policies possible in its day-to-day operation, the Committee on Government Operations should have jurisdiction over policies related to the State of Vermont's information technology systems, now therefore be it

Resolved by the House of Representatives:

That this legislative body moves to amend Rule 25 of the Rules of the House of Representatives to read:

25. At the beginning of each regular session, standing committees shall be appointed having the following names, number of members, and duties:
