Whereas, the Hunger Mountain Coop's Annual Food and Wellness Expo focuses on both regional food and community health resources, and

Whereas, Expo visitors sampled local products as varied as soaps, herbs, beverages, soups, yogurts, and chocolates, and

Whereas, aside from the product displays and samples, health and wellness practitioners offered information and demonstrations on different topics, including aromatherapy, massage, reiki, and yoga, and

Whereas, representatives of nonprofit organizations informed Expo visitors about community wellness resources, and

Whereas, another important aspect of the Expo is the partnership between Hunger Mountain Coop and the Vermont Foodbank, and

Whereas, the Hunger Mountain Coop offered discount coupons to encourage donations to the Foodbank, and

Whereas, the 20th Annual Hunger Mountain Food and Wellness Expo was held on Saturday, November 9th at the Montpelier City Hall, *now therefore be it*

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives:
