



\$318,584	Behavior Risk Factor Survey (BRFS)	To collect information on behavioral risk factors for chronic disease in Vermont
\$252,217	Cancer Control	To develop a comprehensive cancer control program for Vermont
\$423,132	Cancer Registry	To operate a cancer registry
\$968,038	Cancer Screening	To provide outreach, public and professional education for breast & cervical cancer
\$371,452	Chronic Disease Coordination ACA	To strengthen existing chronic disease prevention efforts.
