
SASH IS A SYSTEM




Who SASH Serves


- 3,861 Participants

- We have a “no discharge” policy




Interprofessional Team Approach




Profile of SASH Pilot Site Residents




Number of SASH Participants w/Primary Care Provider




Number of SASH Participants Reporting Annual Exam




Number of SASH Participants with Reported Flu Vaccinations



Number of SASH Participants at Fall Risk








Percent of SASH Participants with HTN Diagnosis and Controlled BP *
