


GIV Long-Term Outcomes Study


In early 2012 the Governor's Institutes of Vermont began work on an alumni evaluation project. Alumni who attended one or more Governor's Institutes between 1983 and 2006 were asked about the impact the programs had and whether that impact had lasting effects on their lives.

93% of respondents reported that GIV influenced them as they made choices about their future.


During high school, GIV was one of my most important educational experiences.

The results of the study showed that GIV, regardless of which Institute respondents attended, often had a long-term legacy, socially and academically, in ways that affected educational and professional outcomes.
