Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to prioritize
State funding for a water pollution abatement grant to the Village of
Brownsville in the Town of West Windsor.

An act relating to a water pollution abatement grant for the Village of
Brownsville

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. PRIORITY AWARD FOR WATER POLLUTION ABATEMENT
GRANT; VILLAGE OF BROWNSVILLE

Notwithstanding the requirements of 24 V.S.A. § 4758 and the Agency of
Natural Resources' Municipal Pollution Control Priority System Rule, the
Department of Environmental Conservation's priority list of projects to be
awarded grants from the Vermont Environmental Protection Agency Pollution
Control Revolving Fund and the Vermont Pollution Control Revolving Fund in

1 fiscal year 2014 shall include a grant to the Village of Brownsville for a water
2 pollution abatement project eligible under 24 V.S.A. § 1652.

3 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

4 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
