



# Art in State Buildings Program – Building Selection – Current DRAFT




# Art in State Buildings Program – Building Selection -PROPOSED DRAFT

BGS Commissioner and State Curator convene with Arts Council Staff to discuss potential buildings for program as part of the overall 5-10 year building plan. During conceptual and planning phases identify all buildings that will qualify for program participation.



All eligible building(s) brought to AISB Legislative Advisory Committee for budget review and approval.



Arts Council initiates Art Selection Panel Process to identify an artist to work with architect upon his/her selection for building.  
BGS building plans include budget for design and fabrication of artwork for each building just like plan for windows & doors. Becomes part of regular planning for every eligible project.

**NOTE**  
Criteria from Program Guidelines:  
Remains the same – with the following adjustment:  
● **SUGGESTED CHANGE:** Eligibility requires minimum estimated construction cost of 2.5 million per project.  
[Art budget = 1% of estimated construction costs per eligible project with minimum \$25,000. \*if estimated construction cost is over 25 million art budget drops to ½ percent of estimated construction costs.]

Plans, concepts and budgets in place. No surprises and more opportunity for innovative designs and integration of artwork into the infrastructure.
