3 Subject: Education; technical corrections

4 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to delete certain
5 sections of H.524, entitled “An act relating to making technical corrections to
6 education laws,” as passed by the General Assembly on January 10, 2014 that
7 would have the inadvertent effect of repealing substantive amendments to
8 education laws enacted in 2013.

9 An act relating to deleting technical corrections to education laws

10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 Sec. 1. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS

12 The following sections of H.524, entitled “An act relating to making
13 technical corrections to education laws,” as passed by the General Assembly
14 on January 10, 2014 are deleted from H.524 to avoid inadvertent repeal of
15 substantive amendments enacted in 2013 to the underlying statutes:
