





# GIV Long-Term Outcomes Study

In early 2012 the Governor's Institutes of Vermont began work on an alumni evaluation project. Alumni who attended one or more Governor's Institutes between 1983 and 2006 were asked about the impact the programs had and whether that impact had lasting effects on their lives.

**93% of alumni reported that GIV influenced them as they made choices about their future.**
