Benefit to Vermont of Participation in the New England Board of Higher Education's Regional Student Program (RSP) Tuition Break

The New England Board of Higher Education (NEBHE), through its Regional Student Program (RSP) Tuition Break, provides a significant tuition discount to Vermont residents, when they enroll at public campuses in Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and Rhode Island to pursue specialized degree programs, which are not offered by Vermont state colleges and universities.

In FY 2014, nearly **620 Vermont residents** enrolled under the RSP Tuition Break and saved an estimated **\$3.4 million** on their annual out-of-state tuition bills. Students enrolled full-time saved an average of **\$7,100** this year.
