Representatives Hubert of Milton, Cole of Burlington, Consejo of Sheldon, Devereux of Mount Holly, Evans of Essex, Higley of Lowell, Lewis of Berlin, Martin of Wolcott, Mook of Bennington, Sweaney of Windsor, and Townsend of South Burlington move that the report of the Committee on Government Operations be amended in Sec. 1 (legislative study; law enforcement structure in the State), in subsection (c) (powers and duties), by striking out subdivisions (8) and (9) in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(8) the role of the Vermont Criminal Justice Training Council and the Vermont Police Academy;

(9) whether to allow full-time deputy sheriffs employed by a county that has opted in to the Vermont State Employees Retirement System under 24 V.S.A. § 290(a) to be considered an “employee” of that System under 3 V.S.A. § 455;

(10) whether there should be created within the State Police the position of Cold Case Investigator; and

(11) any other issues identified in the latest Law Enforcement Advisory Board report.
