

Category 2 - Road Relocation

The town of Charlotte wanted to relocate a portion of Higbee Road where it intersected with Route 7. The existing road intersection was dangerous because of limited sight distances for cars attempting to enter onto Rt. 7.

After studying the alternatives for relocation, the Town determined that a modest relocation through a portion of a conserved farm was the only feasible approach.

VLT worked with the town to identify the corridor and ultimately the Town condemned a 1.55 acre strip of land, terminating the conservation easement over this strip.
