The Dummerston Selectboard voted to have me send along our thoughts on the Vermont Local Roads component of the Transportation Bill. We are opposed to adding VLR into VTrans as a local Technical Assistance Program within the agencies training center.

Vermont Local Roads has been a great asset to our town by training our road crew and has helped to mediate some local road issues. They are accepted within the community as a non-prejudicial party trying to bring local government and residents together on issues involving our roads. If they become an internal segment of VTrans then they would lose that important role.

The administration of grants thru VLR is a much more understood, manageable, and efficient process for a small town like Dummerston, rather than dealing with State and Federal grant administration.
