### As of 01/01/2014 Vermont will issue Real ID compliant Driver's Licenses

A new federal mandate requires you prove your identity. **This must be done in person.**

You will need to bring the following primary documents to establish your identity, proof of legal residence and date of birth: For a detailed list of required items please visit - <http://bit.ly/VTReal>

- Valid, unexpired U.S. Passport **or,**
- Original or Certified copy of U.S. birth certificate **or,**
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad **or,**
- Certificate of Naturalization issued by DHS **or,**
- Certificate of Citizenship **plus,**
- Social Security Card **and,**
- Proof of Residency (if address has changed).

If the current name and the name on the primary identity document are different, you should also bring:

- Court ordered name change document or,
- Marriage certificate or,
- Divorce decree, issued by the courts

In all cases, the document must show a clear trail of name changes originating with the birth name to the current name.

**Renewing by mail will result in the issuance of a "Non-Real ID" compliant license**

### You must renew in person to get a Real ID compliant license

**Non-Real ID license is only valid for 2 (two) years**
