- DRUGGED DRIVER ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS
 - ✓ SFST-Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (100% / unit)
 - ✓ ARIDE – Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (100% / unit)
 - ✓ DRE – Drug Recognition Expert (3 Inspectors / 15% of statewide officers)
 - Current trend 50% of DUI arrest involve alcohol & drugs or drugs
- NEW ENTRANT SAFETY AUDIT (NESA) PROGRAM – VT and Southern PQ based carriers
 - ✓ 100% FMCSA funded program
 - ✓ 3 CVE Inspectors on part time basis
 - ✓ 1 Dedicated part time non-sworn employee (retired law enforcement officer)
 - ✓ 133 Safety Audits completed
 - ✓ 94 Carriers determined to have the adequate basic safety controls
 - ✓ 39 Safety Audits where carrier failed due to inadequate basic safety controls
- COMPLIANCE REVIEW (CR) PROGRAM – VT based carriers
 - ✓ 80% FMCSA funded program
 - ✓ 1 CVE Inspector assigned on a part time basis
 - ✓ 8 Vermont Compliance Reviews conducted
 - ✓ 6 Reviews resulted federal enforcement action
 - ✓ 2 Carriers placed out of service due to inadequate basic safety controls

- SCHOOL BUS INSPECTIONS
 - ✓ Announced Inspections

 - Based on an accident report
 - Report from School District
 - Citizen Complaint
 - ✓ 35 School Bus Inspections

- VALCOUR – computer aided dispatch / records management system (CAD/RMS)
 - ✓ Developed in Vermont by Burlington Police Department
 - ✓ DMV Enforcement & Safety Division implements program on January 1, 2013
 - ✓ 9,869 Enforcement & Safety Division incidents created
 - ✓ 7,374 incidents (75%) handled by 20 CVE Inspectors
 - ✓ Advantages – Real time dispatching from DMV HQ, Officer initiated incidents, real time view of reports and photos.

- MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MCSAP)
 - ✓ 2 New CVE Inspectors hired Spring of 2013
 - ✓ 1 Position remaining to be filled Winter 2014 (Stringent hiring process limits applicant pool – once a CVE Inspector hired takes 3 years to obtain minimum CVE certifications)
 - ✓ 5,452 inspections conducted
 - ✓ 2,740 tickets
 - ✓ 7,909 warnings

- ✓ Federal Fiscal Year 2013 (10/01/12-09/30/13) statewide crash response to serious and fatal injury crashes:

- 186 fatal & non-fatal crashes (FY11 – 250 / FY12 - 197)
- 9 fatal crashes (FY 11 – 7 / FY 12 - 4)
- 177 non-fatal crashes (FY 11 – 243 / FY12 - 193)

- ✓ MCSAP – Commercial Vehicle Safety Plan (CVSP) integrated with SHSP this past year
